*PRIMARY SPELLING BEE
(AGES 5-8)*

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SPELLING BEE

1. Participants must be between the ages of 5 and 8 years old, 5 being the youngest and 8 being the oldest.
2. No more than five (5) persons may enter from one church.
3. This is an individual contest, with individual winners. The church does not place but the individual does. However, we are mindful that we are all winners with Christ.
4. Before the person spells the word, he/she must pronounce the word first.
5. The participant may ask for the word to be repeated before he/she begins spelling the word. Once he/she has begun spelling the word, there will be no verbal clarification of the word.
6. While in the process of spelling a word he/she may correct themselves, however, after the individual completes the word and the judge asks this your final answer, and a response of **yes** is given, then he/she **may not** respell the word.
7. If a word begins with a capital letter, then he/she must use the capital letter while verbally spelling the word, or the spelling of the word will be considered incorrect.
8. The asterisk (*) symbol next to a spelling word indicates that the word is a challenge word and may be used in a tie breaker round to determine or establish a winner. If all the challenge words on this list are utilized then names from the books of the Bible will determine the winner.
